### **CHURCH PLANTING UPDATES:**

While I was in Nepal, I traveled to Jiri. The plan in the future is to make this our next ministry base for Tibetan people groups. Traveling to Jiri has always been on narrow roads and a lot of accidents happen. A few

years ago, the government decided to expand the road and make it two-lane. The work continues and it will be ready in a few months if

they keep up the same pace. It saved me some travel time and it was great to finally see some progress made.

We continue to plant churches in the most unreached and untouched areas, especially Bhotia Tibetans groups, Thami, Sherpa, and amongst the Jirel people. Many groups live very close to the Himalayas, such as Sherpas who provide support for international mountain climbers. Our goal is to have at least one church for every people group and each village in Nepal. We have already planted four churches in the Thami people groups, so we are looking into how we can reach new groups. In Jiri, I was blessed to meet the deputy mayor and other local leaders. We are excited about these new possibilities of making our ministry second base in Jiri. A few weeks ago, Suman and Sukaram, two of the older boys from Mahima Children's home, moved to Jiri to start a small fellowship there. Dinesh and his family will be joining them shortly.






#### **NEPAL UPDATES:**

The nation is in complete lockdown with the second wave of Corona hitting hard. Schools, religious worship places, and public gatherings are closed. Hospitals' beds are packed and the health minister said that they have given up. They have run out of oxygen and people are not getting help, even when they are severely sick. The government has appealed for retired nurses and doctors to be back at work with the increased number of Corona patients. Grocery stores are open during the morning for two hours and are closed the rest of the day. All the rest of the stores are closed and movement is greatly discouraged. Many children are affected by the Indian variant of Coronavirus.

# FAMILY UPDATE:

Only essential traveling is allowed from Norway and Nepal. I left Kathmandu a week before the government stopped all the international flights. I am back in Norway with kids and Anne Lise and I am out of quarantine.
