I love the focus Paul has and his determination and passion toward his goal. I am so excited for the adventures that 2022 will give.

In December and January, I was in Nepal. January became an unusual month for me. This and next month's newsletter will share some updates from my trip. It became quite the adventure.

**Christmas update:** Both Childrens' homes and all the churches had a great Christmas celebration. Thank you so much to all of you who made it possible for kids to have new winter clothes, food, and Christmas gifts. It really blessed me to see people full of joy and happiness and smiles on kids faces. Thank you everyone for your generous gifts!

**Family update:** I am back with my family after a five-week long ministry trip to Nepal. Before I traveled, I was vaccinated and I was being careful. Unfortunately, in the end of my trip I tested Covid-19 positive. I had all the symptoms and especially had a challenge in breathing and I got seriously sick. I had to stay in isolation and quarantine for two weeks in Kathmandu, while I recovered.

Thank you for praying for me. Because of my sickness the newsletter got delayed, so my apologies for that. Now I am back with my kids and wife and I am happy to be back home. Last week Samuel tested positive and he is also fully recovered now.





We continue to focus on church planting, humanitarian help, orphan care with over 85 kids in two childrens homes, Bible college and the elderly home. For 2022, we will continue with this work, but I would like to share a few main goals that we would like to focus on this year.

1. Plant three new churches in the next two years, plant 10 churches total by 2025 and build 15 new buildings for the churches that are already established.
2. Increase our orphan care to ten more kids each year; extend sponsorship program to 10 kids in 2022
3. In the following four years, we will train 120 students and raise them as church planters at our school of ministry
4. Support five more native missionaries in 2022 and reach 25 new native missionaries by 2025.
5. Host and conduct two leadership seminars and one evangelistic crusade in 2022.
6. Complete a mission base for North Nepal and Tibet this year.
7. Renovate the old Mahima Children's Home building and finish the new building by the end of 2022. Finish the outside area for Mahima Children's Home.
8. Humanitarian relief work to 2,500 families in 2022.



Thank you for standing with us, faithfully praying, supporting, and reaching the lost in Asia together with us. We are very excited for what this new year will bring. Thank you so much!
