Samuel and Aron grew up in a children’s home in Kathmandu. Aron works as a warden for the boys and does all our grocery shopping for the children at the home. Samuel is helping Dinesh and Rita in Jiri, Dolakha. The stories of Jeet, Samuel, and Aron highlight the resilience and growth of the children who have come through our care. It is heartening to see how they are doing now.
